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Graduate Certificate in School Superintendent

It requires the completion of 28 semester hours of course work, which includes 32 hours of courses and two semesters (two credit hours each) of internship experiences. Candidates must take and pass ISBE Licensure Exam(s) in their specific area(s) to qualify for the state of Illinois entitlement.
